HKAF's new approach on reversing HIV rising trend

The Centre for Health Protection (CHP) of the Department of Health (DH) has recently released the latest figures on the HIV/AIDS situation in Hong Kong from April to June as of 2019. A total of 137 additional cases of HIV infection were reported from April to June (2nd quarter of 2019). This figure represents a slight decrease of 9 cases compared to the previous quarter. In total, the cumulative number of HIV infections has reached 9,998 cases. With just 2 more cases, the total number will hit or pass 10,000 by next quarter.

And according to the CHP reports, of the 137 new cases, 115 were males while 21 were females. On the transmission front, 70 cases acquired the infection via homosexual or bisexual contact, 25 via heterosexual contact and one via drug injection. In other words, sexual contact remains the major route of transmission regardless of their sexuality.

Although the total number of additional cases has shown a decrease for two consecutive quarters, the Foundation still shows concern about the continuing rising trend of new cases regardless of our relentless efforts on calling citizens to take a more proactive prevention approach. And now, in order to curb the spread of HIV/AIDS among young people more pragmatically, we take a step forward by establishing an outreach centre ("Consulting & Activity centre") in Mong Kok (on Nathan Road) as we see we can reach the hidden high-risk groups more efficiently there.

New Consulting & Activity Centre

The Foundation will launch a new Consulting & Activity Centre in Mong Kok in September 2019. The Foundation will continue to conduct regular activities and free, anonymous and confidential HIV tests to the community by appointment (AIDS Helpline: 2513 0513; WhatsApp: 9093 0335 or LINE: HIVTesting).
